Haas Dean's Startup Seed Fund

Open to all early stage startups w/ at least one UC Berkeley Haas student (undergrad or MBA). The Dean's Startup Seed Fund provides \$5k grants and office space to early stage start ups involving current Haas students. The grants are intended for use in prototype development and customer discovery activities. <u>Apply</u> by **April 13.**

2018 Clinton Global Initiative University

Open to UC Berkeley students. Seeking more support for your Big Ideas proposal? Apply to attend the 2018 Clinton Global Initiative University to develop your idea, network with young leaders, and meet with high level mentors (each year the Blum Center supports limited travel reimbursements for UC Berkeley students to attend)! CGIU is a high-level conference that brings together young leaders who have <u>social impact projects</u> that address a pressing challenge on campus, in their local community, or in a different part of the world. VentureWell Entrepreneur-Team Grant Program

Open to all student entrepreneurs. Receive an E-Team grant and get training through VentureWell's early stage innovator training program. The training provides peer networking, expert coaching, national recognition, and hands-on workshops to move your innovation forward. <u>Apply</u> by **May 2.**

NIBIB and VentureWell DEBUT Challenge

Open to student biomedical entrepreneurs. The National Institute of Biomedical Imaging and Bioengineering (NIBIB) and VentureWell DEBUT challenge offers undergraduate student teams the chance to win up to \$20k by submitting innovative solutions to unmet healthcare problems. <u>Apply</u> by **May 31.**

Autodesk Entrepreneur Impact Program

Open to businesses that are less than 5 years old, have fewer than 10 employees, and have less than \$1M USD in annual revenue. Eligible start-up organizations in the social, environmental, and cleantech industries may qualify for Autodesk software valued up to \$200k per year, or \$600k total for a 3 year period.
