#### **House Residency Applications Open**

The House Residency is an accelerator program built to provide founders with what they need, when they need it, to turn a startup into a scalable, venture back-able business. They offer investment (up to \$120k) to all companies that join the program and work with our companies to raise their seed and Series A rounds of financing to prepare them for growth. Apply by March 23.

#### **NSF SBIR/STTR Proposal Development Course**

Each year, the <u>National Science Foundations's America Seed Fund</u> awards \$190 million in funding to entrepreneurs and small businesses through SBIR/STTR grants to validate high impact technologies. <u>Berkeley IPIRA</u> is hosting a 4-week course from April - May 2018 to provide detailed instruction on developing a competitive proposal for the NSF SBIR/STTR program (timed to coincide with the June 2018 deadline). #### **VentureWell BMEidea Competition**

Open to student biomedical entrepreneurs. The Venturewell national BMEidea competition offers university biomedical entrepreneurs the chance to win up to \$10,000. Participants can also receive critical early stage validation of their ideas. Applications are due **April 4.** Apply <u>here</u>.

#### **VentureWell Entrepreneur-Team Grant Program**

Open to student entrepreneurs. Receive an E-Team grant and get training through Venturewell's early stage innovator training program. The training provides peer
