## **Resources for Early-Stage Innovators**

#### **SOCAP Entrepreneur Scholarship Program**

**Open to social entrepreneurs.** The Social Capital Markets conference (October 23-26, San Francisco) activates capital markets to drive positive social impact by convening key players in the impact investment space. Innovators using market-based solutions to solve a social or environmental challenges can apply for a SOCAP Scholarship. The scholarship covers the \$1,495 conference fee, accommodations, and the pre-conference accelerator program. <u>Apply by June 30.</u>

#### MIT Solve: Call for Solutions

Open to social entrepreneurs with innovative solutions. MIT Solve offers more than \$650,000 in prizes for solutions developed for 4 global challenges: Coastal Communities, Frontlines of Health, Teachers and Educators, and Work of the Future. Once selected, a group of finalists are connected with Solve's community of cross-sector leaders to support the implementation of innovative and scalable ideas. Learn more about Solve and apply by July 1.

#### VentureWell Entrepreneur-Team Grant Program

**Open to student entrepreneurs.** Receive an E-Team grant and get training through VentureWell's early stage innovator training program. The training provides peer networking, expert coaching, national recognition, and hands-on workshops to move your innovation forward. #### **Cyclotron Road Fellowship**

Open to researchers/innovators with a PhD or equivalent experience. Cyclotron Road is an entrepreneurial research fellowship that helps researchers take hard tech innovation to market. As a member of the cohort, you participate in a 2-year fellowship, gain access to research facilities and expertise, and a join a program with mentorship, education and networking. The <a href="next webinar">next webinar</a> will be held on July 18.

#### <u>Africa Prize for Engineering Innovation</u>

Open to citizens from a sub-Saharan African country with an engineering innovation. The Africa Prize encourages ambitious and talented sub-Saharan African engineers from all disciplines to apply their skills to develop scalable solutions to local challenges. Crucial commercialisation support is awarded to a shortlist of innovative applicants through an eight-month period of training and mentoring. 4 prizes range from £10,000 - 25,000. Apply by July 23.

#### **Batchery Incubator Accepting Applications**

**Open to software, hardware, B2B and B2C startups.** The Batchery is an Berkeley-based global incubator for seed stage entrepreneurs ready to take their startup to the next level. The program

costs \$300 per month, is centered in the Bay Area ecosystem, and also runs remotely. Find the tools, education, and mentorship you need to achieve your next step. <u>Apply here</u>.

#### <u>Autodesk Entrepreneur Impact Program</u>

Open to businesses that are less than 5 years old, have fewer than 10 employees, and have less than \$1M in annual revenue. Eligible start-up organizations in the social, environmental, and cleantech industries may qualify for Autodesk software valued up to \$200,000 per year, or \$600,000 total for a 3 year period.
