NIBIB and VentureWell DEBUT Challenge

Open to student biomedical entrepreneurs. The National Institute of Biomedical Imaging and Bioengineering (NIBIB) and VentureWell DEBUT challenge offers undergraduate student teams the chance to win up to \$20k by submitting innovative solutions to unmet healthcare problems. Apply by **May 31.**

GSBI Bay Area Boost Workshop (July 24-26)

Open to social entrepreneurs serving the Bay Area. The Miller Center for Social Entrepreneurship and Catholic Charities of Santa Clara County are joining forces to run a San Francisco Bay Area GSBI Boost, a free 3-day capacity building workshop specifically for social entrepreneurs that are impacting the lives of those in need in the Bay Area. The workshop will take place from July 24 - 26, 2018 in San Jose, California. After this Boost program, participants will have the opportunity to matriculate into the <u>GSBI Online</u> accelerator, a six-month accelerator program. <u>Apply</u> by June 1.

Autodesk Entrepreneur Impact Program

Open to businesses that are less than 5 years old, have fewer than 10 employees, and have less than \$1M USD in annual revenue. Eligible start-up organizations in the social, environmental, and cleantech industries may qualify for Autodesk software valued up to \$200k per year, or \$600k total for a 3 year period.
